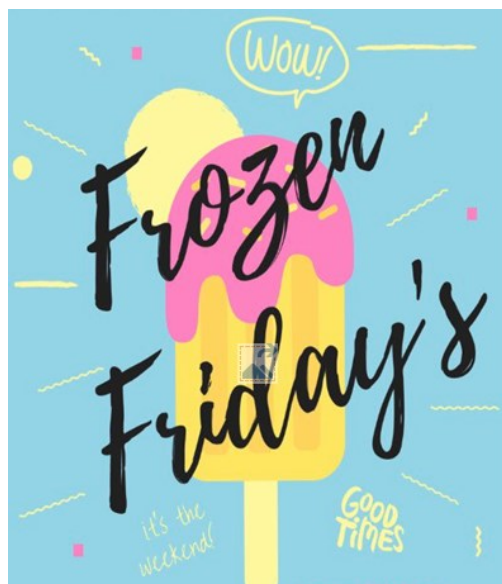
## Frozen Fridays are back!
