Teddys bears picnic on the field. Bring a bear and a snack



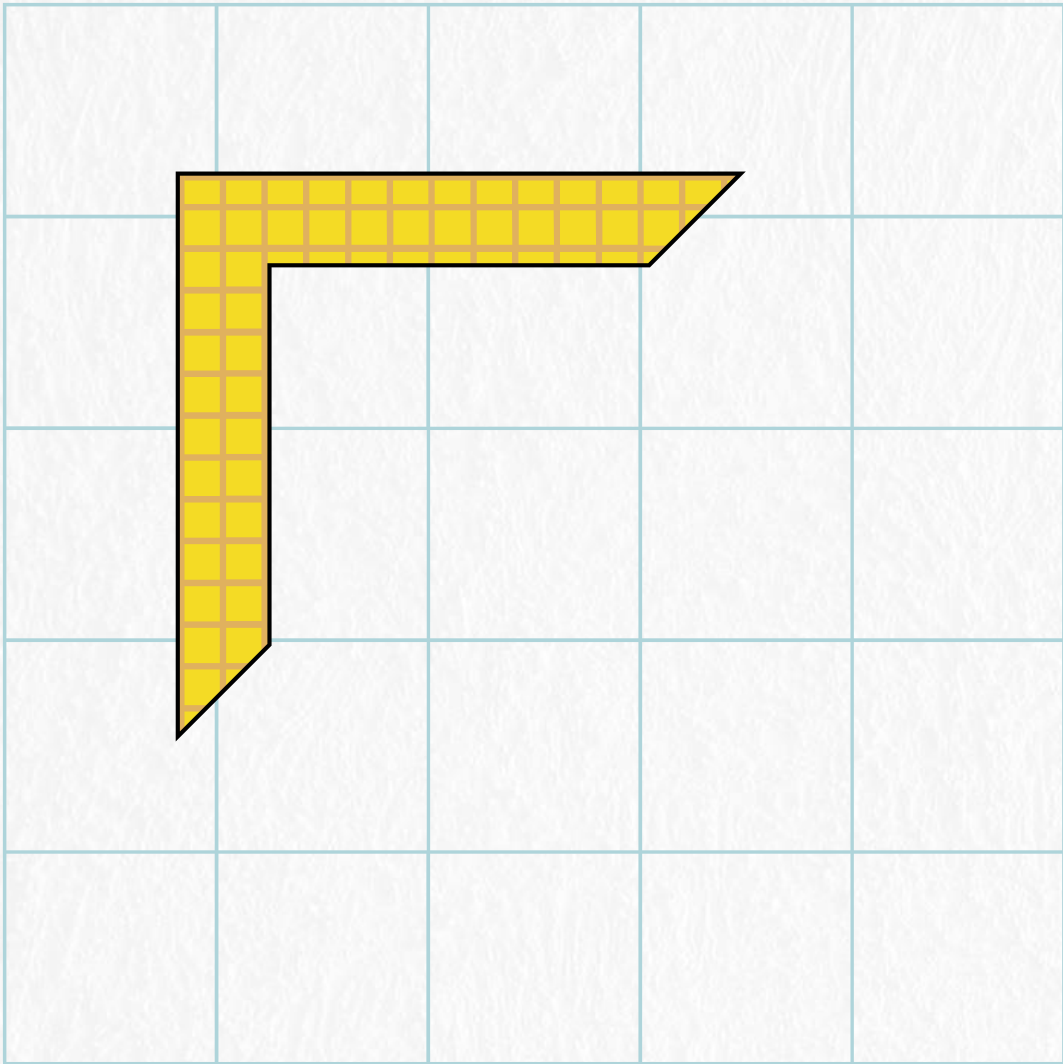

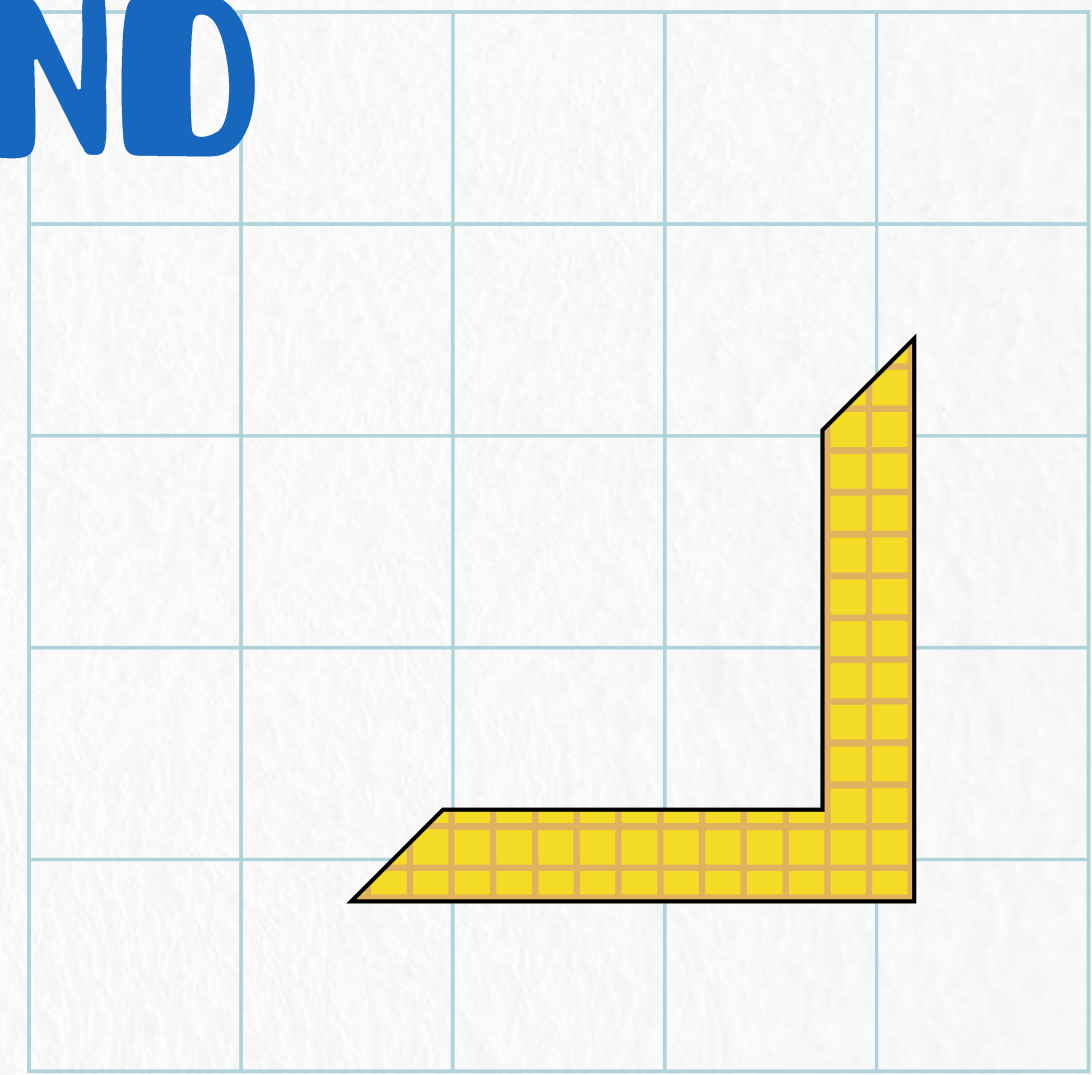

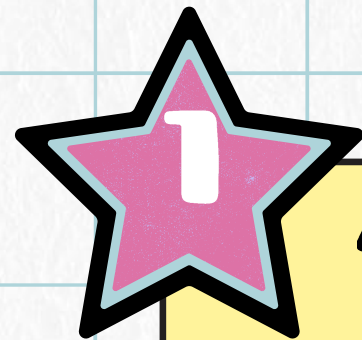

i will record our maths sessions and our continuous maths progression in the room.

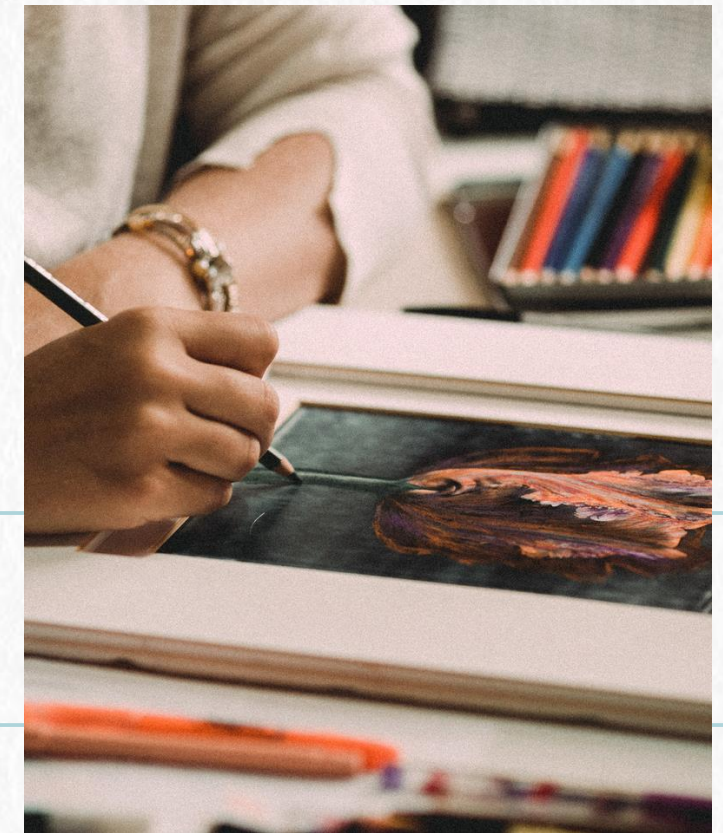
