



## Positive Behaviours – Go for Gold!

- **Responsible** – following instructions

### Level 1 Behaviours

- Unready to learn
- Calling out
- Inappropriate noises
- Leaving seat
- Wasting learning time

### Level 2 Behaviours

- Repetition of level 1 behaviours
- Refusal to listen to instructions
- Significant disruption to learning
- Not completing tasks
- Telling lies and being dishonest
- Being unkind and making fun of others
- Throwing objects
- Swearing in conversation
- Pushing and shoving

### Level 3 Behaviours

- Leaving the classroom without permission
- Repeatedly refusing to listen to adults
- Physical assault against a pupil
- Intentional damage to property
- Discriminatory name calling or comments
- Swearing directly at a person
- Graffiti on school property
- Stealing

### Level 4 Behaviours

- Refusal to follow senior staff request
- Attempting to leave the school site
- Being unsafe
- Violent physical assault against a pupil or member of staff
- Threatening behaviour or comments towards others

Your class **teacher will give you a reminder** about using positive behaviours.

You may be asked to go or take yourself to the **reflection area** to think about your behaviour.

Your teacher may give you something to make it easier to concentrate such as a movement break.

What will happen next?

Your **class teacher will contact your parent** through Class Dojo, phone call or meet them at the end of the day.

With adult support, you will be asked to reflect on what has happened and how you can improve your behaviour.

You will **be sent to a senior member of staff** for a discussion about your behaviour.

**The senior member of staff will speak to your parent.**

You may lose some of your privileges.

These are **serious** behaviours

We will **contact your parent immediately.**

You **may be suspended** from school for a period of time.

These behaviours may **stay on your school record.**
